



Tri-Town Water District No. 1 (TTW) was the first consolidated water district in the State of Vermont. TTW was established on October 27, 1964. The groundbreaking ceremonies occurred August 22, 1966. TTW is over 60 years old. TTW was the first rural water system in the United States to be constructed under public law with federal grant funds and loan funds, and the first to be constructed with grant funds from the State of Vermont. Due to a drought stricken, rural Addison County in 1963, The Aiken-Poage (Sen. George Aiken & Sen. Robert Poage) bill was approved by congress and signed by President Lyndon Johnson on October 7, 1966. The bill provided to TTW a \$1.42 million grant and a \$711,000 loan.

The \$2.8 million project served more than 400 families, mostly dairymen along Lake Champlain. Today

TTW has about 1,723 active services/customers. Last year on average, TTW pumped about 33 million gallons of water per month. TTW has approximately 300 miles of pipe in the ground that brings water to the three towns; Addison, Bridport & Shoreham. TTW has pumping stations in Addison & Shoreham. Pumping stations help to feed the water supply to all areas of the 3 towns more efficiently. TTW is overseen by a Board of Commissioners consisting of; 1 Chairman, 1 Vice Chairman, a total of 3 members from each town and 1 treasurer. TTW employs a total of 4 people, consisting of; 1 superintendent, 2 water operators and 1 office manager.
